

Report on the visit to the EBI/EBC leadership in Rundu in the Kavango Region

The meeting between NHT and the leadership of EBI/EBC (Evangelical Bible Institute and Evangelical Bible Church) went well and both parties expressed the hope and willingness to make the envisaged projects a huge success.

The projects envisaged will be called the EBI Project at Rundu and the EBC Project at DiHokoHoko, near Divundu.

The next steps will be for NHT and EBI/EBC to sign agreements in this regard and to get business plans approved. This will form the basis for the new proposed Concept to be submitted to donor and funding entities to secure the capital to start the projects and to keep them going for 2 years.

These projects will then have to be self-sustainable and further funding will have to come from the SME bank in Windhoek.

Pilot tunnels were installed at DiHokoHoko where the envisaged "Main Technical Training Centre" will be set up in order to start training Trainer of Trainers (TOTs) already. Five persons were identified for this purpose and they will be training and maintaining this pilot project.

The formal processes will start on Monday the 13th of May 2013.
